PMU was established by School Education Department, Government of Baluchistan in 2012. Its implementation laps initially PGEB project (2012-2015) funded by MDTF followed by BEP Project (2015-2019) funded by GPE, BES Project (2019-2021) funded by EU. Currently, PMU is implementing project BHCIP (2020-2025) funded by World Bank and ASPIRE project (2020-2025) funded by MoFEPT (Ministry of Federal Education and Professional Training). All these projects focused mainly on new schools' establishment, upgradation of schools, provision of shelters to shelter less schools, provision of school supplies, furniture, science lab equipment, computer lab equipment, teachers training, and construction/rehabilitation of new classrooms/toilets.
